

REQUESTS FOR TRANSPORTATION

It is the policy of the Iroquois Central School District to offer transportation to district resident students, both public and non-public. Parents are reminded that requests for transportation to **non-public schools** must be received by the District no later than April 1, 2012 to be eligible for the 2012-2013 school year. Requests should be made in writing which include: parents' names, student's name, child's date of birth (copy of birth certificate for child entering kindergarten), address, phone number, school of attendance (next year), the student's grade level (next year) and, if applicable, the child care location. Requests for transportation to and from **child care** location must be received by your *child's school of attendance* by July 1, 2012 to be eligible for the 2012-2013 school year. Requests should be made in writing which include: parents' names, student's name, home address, phone number, school of attendance (next year) and the student's grade level (next year). Please also include the name, address and phone number of the child care provider for both the morning pick up and afternoon drop off, including the days of the week for which this service is requested.
