The Middle School is fortunate to have an opportunity to offer an Academic Afterschool Assistance Program to meet the needs of all our students. If your child is in need of academic assistance and completing schoolwork, he/she could be recommended from a teacher, counselor, or yourself as their parent to attend this program.

The program will run on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:45-4:30 in the MS Stem Room or MS Cafeteria staffed with teachers willing to assist the needs of our students, as well as, provide extra help with areas of deficiency.

Bus transportation has been provided by the district to transport students home after their session. Three buses will transport students home to their designated location in Elma, Marilla, and Wales. Students will board the bus that they would have used during their attendance at the designated three primary buildings. Bus drivers will also be of assistance to help with the correct bus. You may also choose to pick up your child as well.

Or you can send in a note to the main office so our staff can provide your child with an afterschool bus pass. If your child is staying after school for a club, they are also welcome to take the late bus transportation home as well with written permission.
