













## Music Review Sheet - Grades 4 and 5

f, (forte) - loud



p, (piano) - soft

pp, (pianissimo) - very soft or softest

 - (fermata), hold the note longer


| - barline, divides music in small sections like a space between words

 ← keyboard









Tempo- the speed of the beat or the pulse in music



