

ICSD Annual Health Screenings

The Iroquois School Health Services programs supports your child's academic success by promoting health in the school setting. One way that we provide care for your child is by performing health screenings as mandated by the State of New York effective 7/1/2018.

During each school year, the following screening will be required or completed at school:

Vision

Distance acuity for all new entrance students and students in Kindergarten and grades 1, 3, 5, 7 and 11.

Near vision for all new entrance students and students in Kindergarten and grades 1, 3, 5, 7, and 11.

Color perception for all new entrance students.

Hearing

Hearing for all new entrance students and students in Kindergarten and grades 1, 3, 5, 7, and 11.

Scoliosis

Scoliosis (spinal curvature) for boys in grade 9, for girls in grades 5, and 7.

Health Appraisals

Health Appraisals including Body Mass Index and Weight Status Category Information is required for all new entrance students, students in Kindergarten, and students in grades 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11.

Dental Health Certificate

A Dental Health Certificate is requested for all new entrance students, students in Kindergarten, and students in grades 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11.

You will receive a note or a phone call from the school nurse on any findings of screenings done at school.
