

DRIVER EDUCATION ATTENDANCE POLICY
(Hosted by Iroquois Central School)

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ!

In an effort to avoid confusion and misunderstanding regarding attendance for Driver Education, the following notification is being provided. Driver Education is a serious time commitment. Do NOT sign up for Driver Ed if you know you will be missing class for ANY reason (including but not limited to academic events, athletic events, religious events, family vacation, employment obligations, etc.). Attendance is **mandatory**. This is a New York State Department of Education requirement. Students are allowed (2) absences which must be made up on the make-up days at the end of the session you have registered for. Please be advised that students missing more than (2) days will not be able to satisfy the minimum 48-hour requirement and will not be eligible to receive the MV-285 Certificate of Completion (no refund). In the event of unexpected cancellations or delays, Iroquois reserves the right to add dates and/or time as needed in order to meet the state required hours of instruction.

If you will not be able to adhere to the attendance requirements, you must withdraw from the program **before** it begins. You are entitled to a full refund (less online credit card/echeck transaction fee if applicable) if you withdraw your registration by the designated date (Session 1: by 10:00am on June 24th, Session 2: by 10:00am on July 19th). There are NO refunds once the session has begun regardless of the reason.
