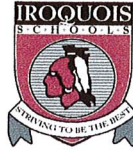

Dear Parents:

Each year our school buses travel some 800,000 miles. Our daily trips total approximately 4,400 miles – the equivalent of a trip to Dallas and return each day! Despite the incredible number of miles and hours on our highways, our transportation department has an exemplary safety record. But highway safety is only part of this success story.

It is the combined effort of every student, their parents/guardians, teachers and administrators that make the system work. Only through mutual cooperation have we been able to transport students safely and efficiently.

In preparation for another safe operating year, please review the information below to familiarize yourself with our basic rules and procedures. If increment weather forces the district to close schools, official notice will be given to television stations WGRZ (ch. 2), WIVB (ch. 4) and WKBW (ch. 7). Official notice will also be given to radio station WBEN AM (930). In addition, every household will receive a connect-ed telephone call. Occasionally, weather conditions become severe after the school day has begun, necessitating an early dismissal. Since the early dismissals cannot be foreseen, parents/guardians are reminded that children need a definite place to go if they are released at midday. Make arrangements now to be sure that your child knows what to do and where to go if they are released early from school.
